To acquire points, the following applies:

1. The rider for equitation and the horse or pony for hunters, must compete at a minimum of four (4) shows in the division for which you want to earn points.
2. The rider for equitation and the owner for hunters must be a member.
3. To be eligible for Trainer Awards a trainer must have two or more students or are not family members.
4. Points shall accrue as of the day of the show membership was joined or as of the postmark, if mailed.
5. A registration form and fee of \$10.00 is required. Family: \$15.
6. Points will be calculated as follows:  
1st-10, 2nd-6, 3rd-4, 4th-2, 5th-1, 6th-1/2, Champion 10, Reserve Champion 6.
7. Points will start with the first show of the season (12/07/08). Awards will be presented at the final show of the season (11/29/09).
8. Double points will be awarded for SPS Medal Classes and Hunter Classics at the Medal Show in October.
9. Points may be contested up to November 1, 2009. After that date all points will be considered accurate and final.
10. Short Stirrup Hunter does not count towards High Point Hunter.
